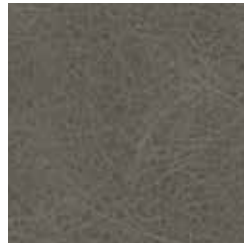

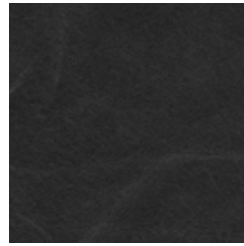

Highland is a premium pull-up aniline leather rich in natural beauty and rustic charm. The distressed aged appearance of Highland is achieved by sourcing brand-free hides with prominent neck creasing and a varying degree of wax and oil embedded into the leather. The wax provides a dramatic pull-up effect, which shows the variation in light and dark areas across the hide especially when the leather is stretched or pulled against the grain. The oil prevents the wax from drying, adding to Highland's supple beauty. Highland is a high quality Italian leather that will improve over time, developing an aged patina.

- Due to the nature of pull-up aniline leathers, colour variation across the hide and between hides is unavoidable and part of the characteristic of this type of leather. Further, because these are aniline hides it is not always possible to obtain an exact colour match to the leather displayed in our sampling.

ENVIRONMENT

- Leather is an agricultural by-product
- The tannery uses water-based dyes and no hazardous substances are used, complying with the European Union's REACH standard

- The Green Star Rating Tool states "Where at least 90% of an item's mass is certified to a GBCA recognised standard, the item can be entered as a certified product at Level A, B or C." Therefore any leather can be used as leathers are almost always under 10% by weight of a furniture item
