



# **Ecoustic® Bio Tile Installation + Care**

13 x 4-way Clear ABS joiner Clips
(inc. 1 spare) Clip template

Power drill

#### **Essential**



Clean hands Handle with care during installation



Spirit level

#### **CLIPS**



# Complete

Use a complete clip for each junction of 4 tiles



#### Half

Break a clip in half for each straight edge 2 tile joins



### **Ouarter**

Break clip into quarters for each single tile corner

#### WALL INSTALLATION

First corner


#### Step 1

Draw a datum line on the wall and mark the setout point in which the tiles are to be installed.



Using fixings suitable for your substrate, fix the first corner in place.

Note: Always use a mechanical means of fixing. 4 x joiner clips recommended for wall applications



#### Step 3

Use the supplied template to fix the next 3 clips (plus clips for adjoining tile if required) in place. Use 6 clips for ceiling installations.






# Step 4

Use the template work up the wall in columns. Finish the top with corner clips on corners + edge clips on straight joins.


Note: never use the tiles to measure spacing.

Wall Datum




## Step 5

Following the installation of two columns of clips, double check the spacing by installing the first column of tiles, ensuring Ecoustic Infills are inserted into each tile shell. Always stay one column ahead of the installed tiles to ensure the tiles don't interfere with the clip spacing.




## Step 6

Install the rest of your clips and put up the tiles to finish.







# **CEILING INSTALLATION**

Follow **Steps 1 - 4** on page 2 - allowing for 6 joiner clips per tile at Step 3.

# **Steps 5 + 6**

Minimum 1 external mechanical fastener per tile plus adhesive recommended.

#### **Please Note**

Ecoustic Bio Tiles are manufactured from natural materials and will stain if soiled or wet with liquids.

## **Regular Care**

- Protect from direct heat and sunlight.
- Do not expose to moisture, liquids or substances that may cause staining.
- To prevent dust build up, lightly dust with a soft cloth without repeated rubbing or excessive pressure.
- Do not clean with liquids, powders, chemicals, wet wipes or damp cloths.
- Wetting of the tile surface may permanently mark or change the colour of the tile.
